### Cairo

The capital of Egypt & one of the world's largest urban areas that offers many sites to see. It is an amazing city full of life and movement, an open museum, composed of a mixture of ancient and modern. Cairo provides great culture, including art galleries and music halls, It also provides some of the grandest accommodations and restaurants in the world , and an incredible selection of shopping.



### Alexandria

It is the pearl of the Mediterranean and the largest port in Egypt, famous for its exceptional location, its mild climate throughout the year and its sandy beaches, attracting thousands of visitors there in the summer. The highlights of the city include the catacombs of Kom El Shogafa, the Citadel of Qait Bey, the Pillar of Pompey. The Montazah Palace and its incredible gardens are another of its major attractions..



### Luxor

Has frequently been characterized as the "world's greatest open air museum", as the ruins of the temple complexes at Karnak and Luxor stand within the modern city. Immediately opposite, across the River Nile, lie the monuments, temples and tombs on the West Bank Necropolis, which include the Valley of the Kings and Valley of the Queens.



### Aswan

Egypt's sunniest southern city. Its ancient Egyptian name was Syene. One of the best views of Aswan is from the Aga Khan's Mausoleum on the west bank, For total relaxation, take a felucca around the islands. Just south of Aswan is the Old Dam built around the turn of the century and later increased in height. Just south of the dam is the beautiful island temple complex of Philae. Even further to the south is the mighty Aswan High Dam built in the 1960s.



### Siwa

The off-shore road will take you through the dunes of the Great Sand Sea desert to the Siwa oasis, the biggest oasis in the Sahara and the most important. The fortress of Shali protected the Temple of the Oracle, where Alexander the Great became king of Egypt. Enjoy the magical effects of Cleopatra's baths Huge, clean, bubbling cold spring. And surprisingly get fun with a great shopping in Shali Fortress.



### The White Desert

Experience the caravan routes of Berber through the Western Sahara Egypt desert. Bahreya Oasis site of the natural hot springs and the Valley of the Gold Mummies. Camp under the stars between the "Inselbergs" of the spectacular White and Western Deserts and experience the Black and Flower Desert till the Crystal Mountain.



### Hurghada

Hurghada was founded in the early 20th century, and until a few years ago, remained a small fishing village. But today, it has gone on to become the foremost tourist resort of the Red Sea coast and an international center for aquatic sports. If it takes place in or on the water you can do it here: windsurfing, sailing, deep-sea fishing, swimming, but- above all- snorkeling and diving.



### Sharm El Sheikh
